

OVERVIEW

Australian School-based Apprenticeships (ASbA) or Traineeships are an Australian Government initiative that enables secondary school students to complete the Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) or the Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL) while undertaking paid part-time employment and completing a nationally recognised qualification.

An ASbA must complete a minimum of 15 hours per week combined employment and training, which may be averaged over the duration of the Training Contract.

Typically, ASbAs spend one or two days per week in industry working, while gaining a qualification delivered by a TAFE or a Registered Training Organisation. ASbAs also provide opportunities of additional employment, after school hours, on weekends and during holidays.

Martial Journey academy of martial arts has chosen to partner with the International College of Kenshusei (RTO) and VECCI Apprenticeships Services, to deliver our School-based Traineeship programme.

PREREQUISITES

To undertake the Martial Journey School-based Traineeship, we require that you are:

- 15yrs or older,
- be a permanent resident of Australia,
- a member of Martial Journey academy of martial arts,
- have achieved green belt ranking or higher through our academy,
- prepared to commit to a minimum of 3 training sessions each week – 2 of which will be for on the job learning, and 1 for training purposes.
- prepared to commit to some home study and research time.

COURSE OUTLINE

SRS20306 Certificate II in Sport Coaching (martial arts) – 1st year

SRS30306 Certificate III in Sport Coaching (martial arts) – 2nd year

This Certificate II & III in Sport Coaching Qualification was originally released by Sport and Recreation Australia (SRTA) under the authority of the (ANTA) Australian National Training Authority and is now recognised by the Service Industry Skills Council (SISC).

This sport industry training package qualification holds the relevant units of competence for the various sporting disciplines and allows participants to attain formal recognition from the government and the community for their sporting discipline studies. This qualification is a benchmark and now sets the standard for all sporting disciplines. The qualification opens the door to formal career path opportunities and of course articulation into further studies under this framework. The training package is suitable to sporting disciplines including but not being limited to the disciplines mentioned below.

What sporting discipline can I do?

Specialisations include but are NOT necessarily limited to, Basketball, Canoeing, Cricket, Equestrian, Gymnastics, Martial Arts, Rugby League, Rugby Union, Sailing, Squash, Surf Lifesaving, Swimming, Touch football, Volleyball.

You may now train in your favourite sporting activity / study this training package and upon successful completion of all units, receive a government recognised qualification.

Delivery modes:

This qualification can be achieved through a combination of the following delivery modes: Home study, online, face to face workshops, and on the job (sporting activity) under the direction of qualified trainers and assessors.

Assessment

This course is a combination of physical and theoretical sporting studies. Assessment is based on successful completion of all workbook activities, portfolio development (personal CV, previous certification, and references), attendance at seminars, and successful completion of written assessment paper for each cluster of units. Final assessment for this qualification is a collaborative effort between Martial Journey academy of martial arts and the International College of Kenshusei that will highlight the student's on the job and practical performance.
